My Usual Workflow

- Camera Calibration Choose Camera Profile
- Lens Corrections Turn on Enable Profile Corrections and Remove Chromatic Aberrations
- Straighten if needed
- Crop

Basic adjustments Optionally convert to B&W Local adjustments Go away and come back Print or export



- Lost detail in highlights and shadows \bullet
- Too much saturation
