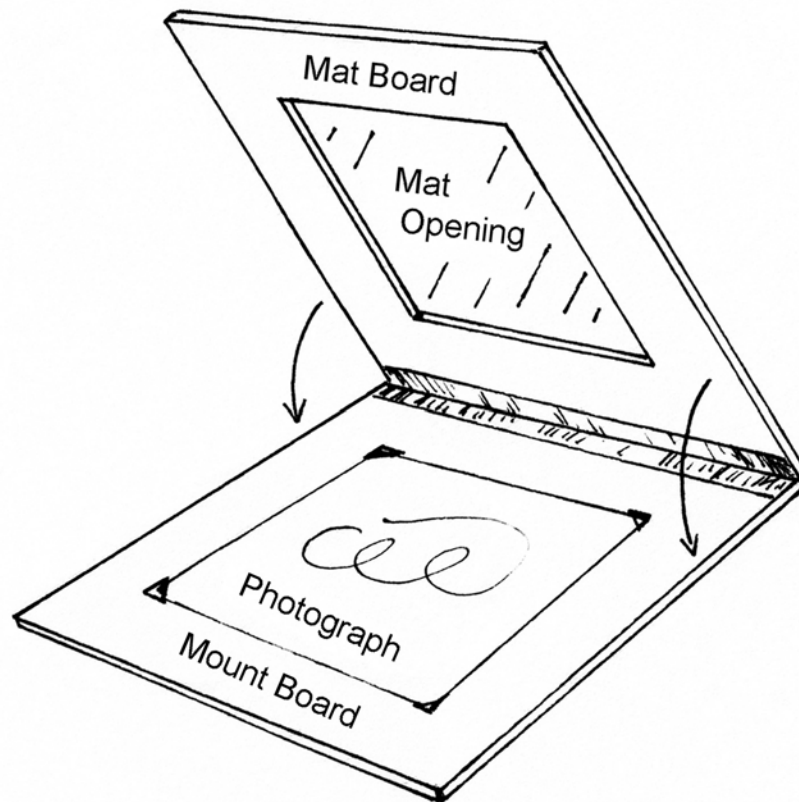


Reusable Fold-Mat for Photographs

Competition or Exhibit Presentation

(Photographs can be replaced without damage to mat or photograph)



- Use 4-Ply mat boards for both the front cover mat and back mount. Select white 100% rag boards for archival quality.
- Cut a window opening, slightly smaller than your photograph, in the front mat board. Or purchase pre-cut mat boards sized for your photograph.
- Top edges of both the window cover-mat and mount board are butted together. Tape is overlapped along the butted edges of these two boards to create the folding (hinged) mat. Art and scrapbook supply stores will have acid-free tapes and other products for an archival quality mat.
- Self-adhesive Photo Corners will attach and hold the print on to the mount board. The photograph is viewed through the window of the top mat board.
- Two small pieces of double-stick tape can be applied to the inside lower corners, between mat and mount boards, to keep the fold-mat from flipping open when handled.
- Photographs will easily slip out of the Photo Corners and another photograph can be slipped into the fold-mat without damaging either the mat or photograph.
